



PEI Potatoes Future Leaders Bursary

The PEI Potatoes Future Leaders Bursary supports the educational goals of Island students who are committed to building a future in Prince Edward Island's potato industry. This bursary is awarded to a student who demonstrates a meaningful connection to the potato sector—whether through personal experience, family involvement, employment, or community engagement—and who is pursuing a post-secondary college program or university degree that will enhance their ability to contribute to the industry.

Eligible applicants must be entering their first year of schooling and must intend to pursue a career within the PEI potato industry upon completion of their studies. As part of the application, students must clearly outline how their chosen educational program will prepare them to enter, remain in, or advance within the industry.

This bursary aims to encourage and support the next generation of leaders who will strengthen, innovate, and sustain the potato industry in Prince Edward Island.

Bursary amount: \$2,000 (up to five per year)

Application must include a one-page submission outlining your involvement in the PEI Potato Industry, area of study, and the expectation of how this will assist you in returning to the industry.

Deadline to apply: May 15th
