THE CREDIT SYSTEM

- KRHS runs on a semester system
- Students take 4 courses from September to February and 4 courses from February until June
- Students must earn 50% in a course to receive credit
- Most courses are worth I credit

COURSE CODING

Each unique course code is composed of seven characters, with a course title associated with it.

Example: MAT521A - Foundations of Mathematics 11

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The minimum requirements to graduate from a PEI high school are as follows:

- A minimum of **20 credits** which must include:
 - 3 English credits (must include English 621 or English 671)
 - 2 credits in mathematics
 - 2 credits in science
 - 2 credits in social studies (one must focus on Canadian social studies)
 - PED401
 - CEO401
 - I credit from a designated list that fosters creativity or innovation or a French language course.
 - 5 credits must be at the Grade 12 level, including ENG 621/671. (621 or 801)

WHY YOU NEED TO BE THINKING ABOUT THIS NOW

UNIVERSITY VS. COLLEGE

University

- Admission requirements will vary by program applying to
- Generally need 5 academic grade 12 level courses (621 and 611), including ENG 621
- Other 4 courses will depend on program applying for
- Min 70-75% average, competitive programs will require higher


College

- Can be more competitive than university admissions
- Each program will have its own set of requirements varying from successful graduation from gr. 12 to needing gr. 12 physics
- Having involvement/ extra curriculars/ volunteering within your field of interest helps your application for admissions, i.e. taking high school trades courses if applying to a trades program at college

You need to work backwards! If you know what you need to take in grade 12, then you need to take the equivalents in grade 1!

Eg. Need MAT621A, then need to register in MAT521A in grade 11




MY BLUEPRINT AND COURSE REGISTRATION

LOG ON TO MYBLUEPRINT.CA/PEI — CLICK ON "HIGH SCHOOL"



- Courses should be listed in order of importance, including your electives- required at top
- Follow along with the "cheat sheet" posted on the school website
- Keep in mind the following things:
 - Graduation requirements
 - ADP requirements
 - Are you registering in the right level course? Eg. MAT 521A
 vs. 521B vs. 621K
 - Did you fill in your 2 alternates?

Example Grade 11 Registration



Notes:

- Courses should be listed in order of importance- for example, all required courses for gr. 11 should be at the top, and electives should be listed at the bottom. Required courses for gr 11 are indicated, above.
- Within the required courses, there are still some options to meet these requirements:
 - English Requirement: ENG 521A Academic English or ENG 571 Literacy Interventions- Recommendations will be made by current English teacher
 - Math Requirements: MAT 521A Academic Math, MAT 521B Pre-Calculus Math or MAT 621K Workplace Math (must register in if took MAT 421K)
 - Science Requirement: BIO 521A, CHM 521A, PHY 521A (many people try all 3 in gr. 11, others will look up what the requirements are in gr 12 for the program they wish to take in post-secondary and take their equivalent in gr. 11), BIO 801A, AGS 621 Aggiscience (the last 2 are options if you took SCI 701 in grade 10)
 - o <u>Social Studies Requirements:</u> you need to take one more social studies course for graduation requirements. If you did not take GEO 421A in grade 10, you need a Canadian content SS, your options age; LAW 521A, HIS 621A Canadian History, HIS 621B PEI History. If you did take GEO 421, you can chose from the previous list, or look at these options (more than one can be chosen in your plan): ECO 621A Economics, ENT 521 Entrepreneurship, POL 621 Political Studies (online), GEO 621 Global Studies
- <u>Electives</u>: once you get the top 4 courses filled, you can then add more courses to make up your 8 slots, plus, choose 2 alternates. Some options you can chose from are: Other science courses, Other social studies courses, Flexible learning options such as ISC 521 or CMP 521, Arts based courses like MUS 521 or ART 501, CWS 501 or 502, Trades courses, CUL 801, FAM 621, ACC 621, PHP 501, RES 501, PED 801 or Transitions 602 @ Holland College
- ** if you are registering for a course that is 2 credits (course code ends in a 2) you will only fill in 7 courses to
 make 8 credits **if you are registering for a trades course you must choose 2 such as CAR 801A and CAR 801B
- . If you are in ADP please remember you need 1 agriscience courses and a co-op in an agriculture field
